Argus Media Interviews Mr. Nilesh Bhattad to Understand CBAM Tax.

The European Commission has confirmed that the FTA offers no exemption from CBAM, which is concerning for India's steel sector because of high default emissions values and roadblocks to getting emissions verified, market participants told Argus. Currently, Indian hot-rolled coil (HRC) faces a prohibitive CBAM default value of over 4t of CO₂ per tonne of steel, implying an additional cost of more than €200/t (\$239/t) purely from carbon charges. EU CBAM Reporting Rules 2026 for Suppliers and EU Buyers

CBAM reporting has become mandatory from January this year, marking a major shift in how exports to the European Union are regulated. This means that any supplier exporting products made of iron and steel, aluminium, or cement from India to the EU must now comply with strict CBAM reporting and verification requirements. While the actual CBAM declaration is submitted by the EU buyer, the responsibility for providing accurate and verified emissions data lies squarely with the exporter.
